Introduction: This TAA details the applicability of courses from the COTC AAS in an Approved Health-Related Program to the University of Cincinnati (“UC”) Online BTAS Applied Administration-Healthcare Leadership in UC Online. Students who complete the AAS in an Approved Health-Related Program at COTC have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from [Originating Institution Name] who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into UC Online will enter with 60.5-65 hours of transfer credit applicable toward the BTAS Applied Administration-Healthcare Leadership degree.

Admission Criteria: Completing the courses on the appendices below does not guarantee admission to UC Online.

- Earn AAS degree at COTC in an allied health or health-related program; or earn any associate degree in addition to an allied health or health-related program certificate
- Hold a certification/licensure in their area of practice
- Complete a UC Admission Application for the BTAS Applied Administration-Healthcare Leadership program (including providing official transcripts from prior attended institutions)

Minimum GPA: 2.00

BTAS Completion: Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.

Admission Period: COTC students must be admitted to the UC Online during the duration of this TAA (i.e. between August 1, 2026 and July 31, 2029).

TAA Effective Date: August 1, 2026

TAA Expiration Date: July 31, 2029

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This TAA becomes effective upon its signing and will remain effective through the expiration date noted above. At the end of this time, the TAA will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. COTC and UC Online agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting this TAA occur. Additions and/or amendments to this TAA must be in writing and signed by the Parties.

This TAA will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to changes in program curriculum.

COTC students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
