ADMISSIONS & DEADLINES

- Completion of the courses on this worksheet does not guarantee admission to the College of Allied Health Sciences
- Students who complete the AAS Respiratory Care have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.
- Students must be admitted to the College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement.
- **Minimum GPA:** 2.5
- **Admission Criteria:** A student must:
 - Hold an AAS Respiratory Care from RACC
 - Hold credentials as a Certified Respiratory Therapist (CRT) by the National Board for Respiratory Care (NBRC) and be RRT (Registered Respiratory Therapy) eligible
- **BS Completion:** Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.
