Degree/Program: Bachelor of Science (“BS”) / Health Sciences: Pre-Occupational Therapy (Online) (“Health Sciences: Pre-OT (Online)”)

Introduction: This TAA details the applicability of courses from the Hawkeye Community College AAS OTA to the University of Cincinnati (“UC”) BS Health Sciences: Pre-OT (Online) in the College of Allied Health Sciences. Students who complete the AAS OTA at Hawkeye Community College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from Hawkeye Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the College of Allied Health Sciences will enter with 65-68 hours of transfer credit applicable toward the BS Health Sciences: Pre-OT (Online) degree. All degree requirements are completed online.

Admission Criteria: Completing the courses on the appendices below does not guarantee admission to UC BS Health Sciences: Pre-OT (Online) program.

A student must:

- Hold an AAS in OTA from Hawkeye Community College
- Hold credentials as an occupational therapy assistant by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy; conditional acceptance is granted into the program for those who are eligible to take the OTA exam and have a plan in place to complete the exam.
- Complete a UC application (including submission of official transcripts from all institution(s) attended and payment of application fee).

Minimum GPA: 2.5

BS Completion: Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC Student Success Coordinators will work with each student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.

Admission Period: Hawkeye Community College students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this TAA (i.e. between August 1, 2026, and July 31, 2029).

TAA Effective Date: August 1, 2026

TAA Expiration Date: July 31, 2029

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This TAA becomes effective upon its signing and will remain effective through the expiration date noted above. At the end of this time, the TAA will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Hawkeye Community College and the UC College of Allied Health Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting this TAA occur. Additions and/or amendments to this TAA must be in writing and signed by the Parties.

This TAA will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to changes in the program curriculum.

Hawkeye Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
