ADMISSIONS & DEADLINES

- Completion of the courses on this worksheet does not guarantee admission to Blue Ash College or the AAS Veterinary Technology Program
- Students who complete the GATEWAY AS have satisfied the UC General Education requirement.
- Students must be admitted to Blue Ash College during the duration of this agreement.
- **UC Minimum GPA:** 2.0
- **Program Minimum Content GPA:** 2.75
- **Selective Admission Criteria:**
 - Complete all freshman year courses
 - Minimum grade of C in science courses (C- does not meet the requirement)
 - [Veterinary Experience Document](#) outlining a minimum of 20 hours of veterinary-related experience, documented by a Veterinarian or Registered Veterinary Technician with credentials.
 - GATEWAY Notes:
 - A portion of the selective admission application will require students to provide documentation of spring semester schedule at GATEWAY to demonstrate that progress is being made towards completing all coursework required in the first year of the AAS Veterinary Technology program. An unofficial GATEWAY transcript from the Student Self-Service Center in My Path is acceptable.
 - Students who are still completing spring semester coursework at GATEWAY will be offered *conditional admission* to the AAS Veterinary Technology program until final spring semester grades are received.
 - Students must provide spring semester final grades from GATEWAY via email to the Veterinary Technology Department (ucbavettech@ucmail.uc.edu) as soon as possible to allow time for the selective admission application review. An unofficial Gateway CTC transcript from the Student Self-Service Center in My Path is acceptable.
 - The Veterinary Technology program will verify that all required first year coursework is completed and meets the program admission requirements.
 - *Conditional admission* will be revoked, resulting in dismissal from the Veterinary Technology program if spring semester grades do not meet the admission requirements or are not provided the due date to accept a position in the clinical program as stated in the acceptance letter. Depending on the circumstances, an offer of admission may be withheld until spring semester grades are provided.
 - Official transcripts containing spring semester grades must be sent to UCBA by the second week of class of the clinical year. Student financial aid cannot be disbursed until official transcripts are received and processed.
- **Selective Admission Timeline:** Students must apply to UCBA for the summer semester and confirm their admission to access the selective admissions application that is required for this program. GATEWAY students must abide by the prescribed guidelines to begin the clinical portion of the AAS Veterinary Technology program in the summer semester. To ensure that students taking spring semester courses at GATEWAY have the required permissions to access the selective admission application, some of the listed deadlines are earlier than deadlines published online (denoted by “*”).
 - February 1* - Complete admission application for UCBA for summer term
 - March 1* - Confirm admission to UCBA for summer term
 - Late April – Complete selective admission application for AAS Veterinary Technology program (date varies – refer to website)
 - Within 1 week of receiving acceptance letter – Confirm admission to AAS Veterinary Technology program (letters sent mid-May)
 - Last Week of May – Mandatory Veterinary Technology Program Orientation (date varies – refer to acceptance material)
 - First Week of June – Classes begin for clinical year of program (different from summer semester start date; date varies)
