Students perform a prepared piece of their choice for a master teacher who provides written assessment and comments that are shared with each participant. This “self-competition” is focused on student growth and takes place in a public recital setting.

Age group: K-8th grades

Practice your instrument, gain new friends and have fun learning pieces while improving your technique! CCM Prep faculty are planning a full week of classes, chamber music and orchestra rehearsals, mini-lessons, enrichment, games and fun activities for suzuki and traditional string students. Age Group: High School

During this one-week intensive, students will rehearse and perform in chamber music ensembles and string orchestra, participate in masterclasses with seasoned professionals, and utilize the resources of CCM. Classes will cover chamber music repertoire, orchestral literature, and music theory, and students will explore the multiple majors offered at CCM.
