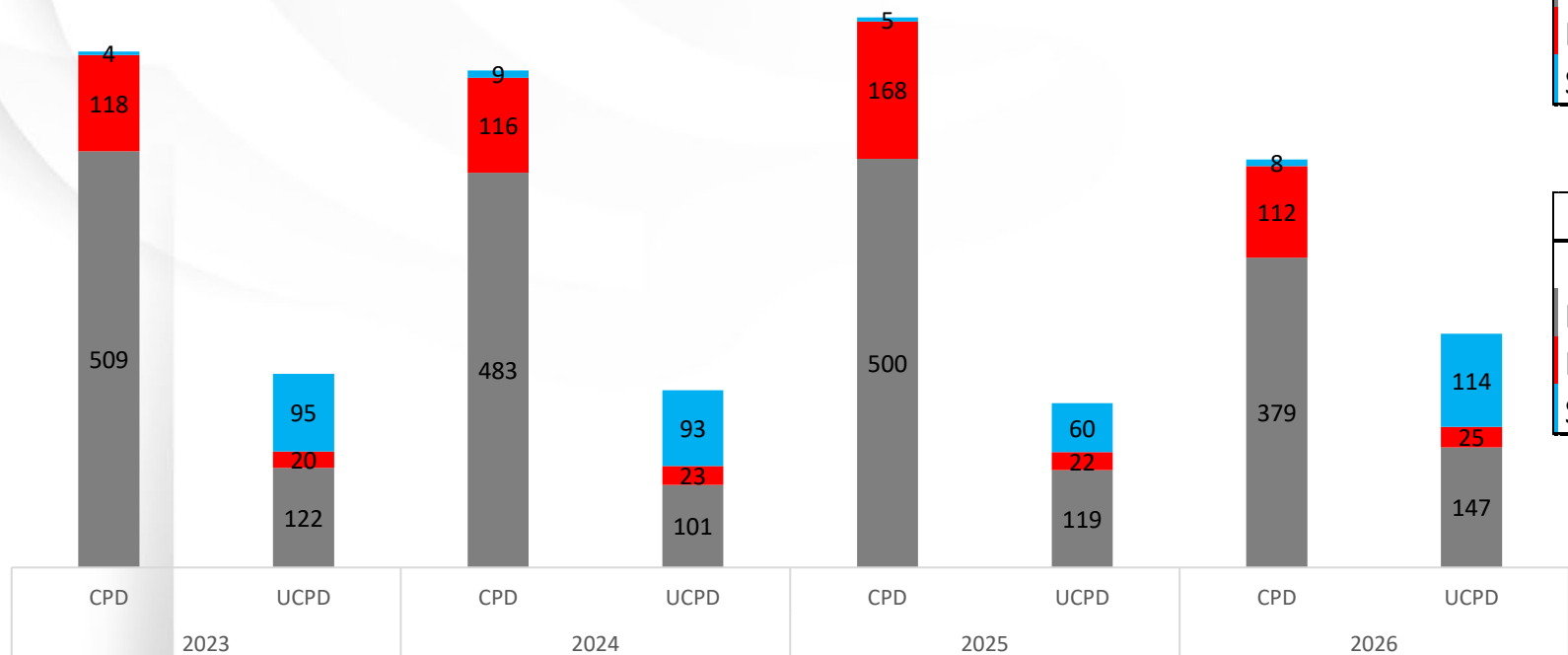

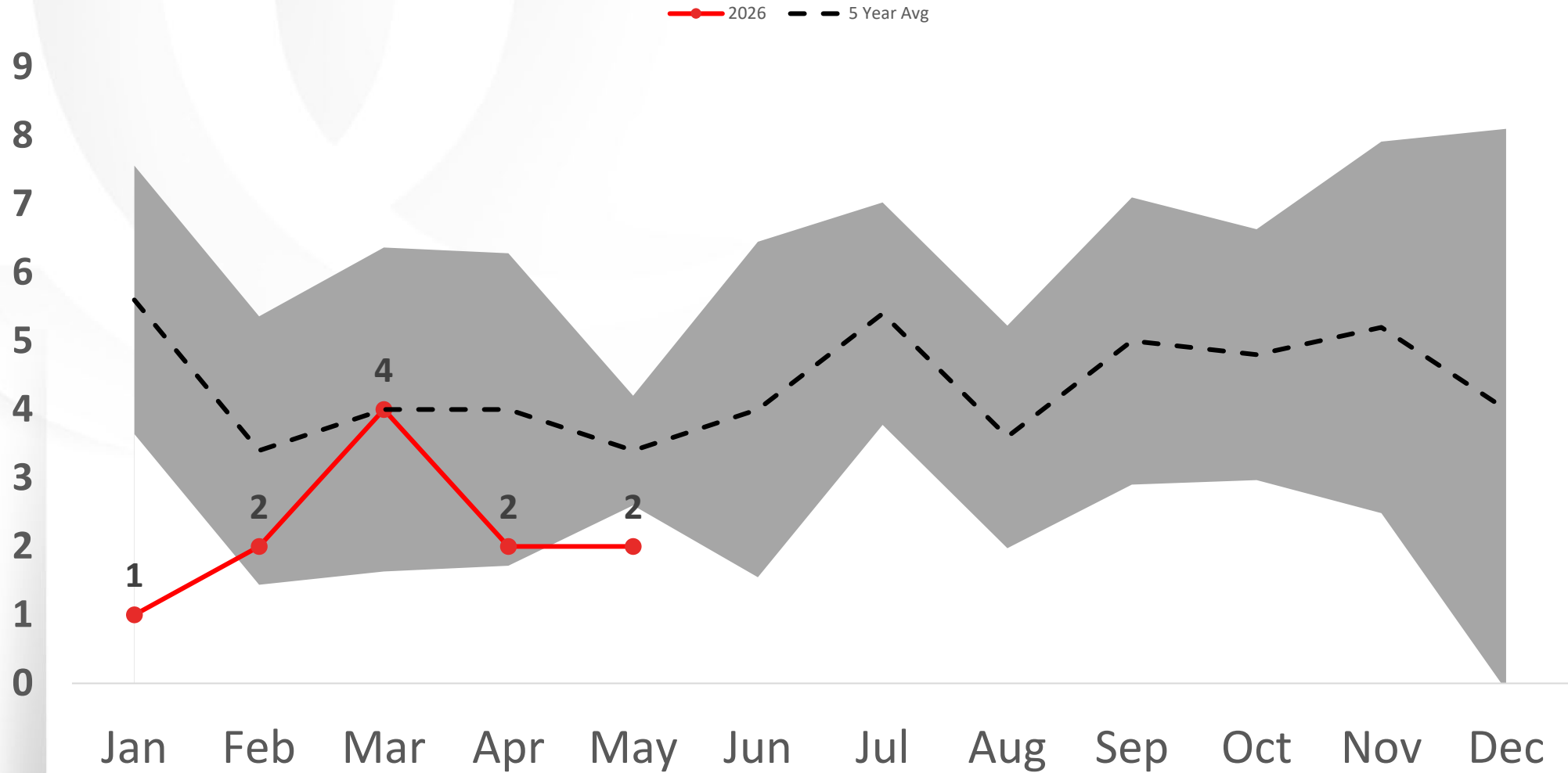

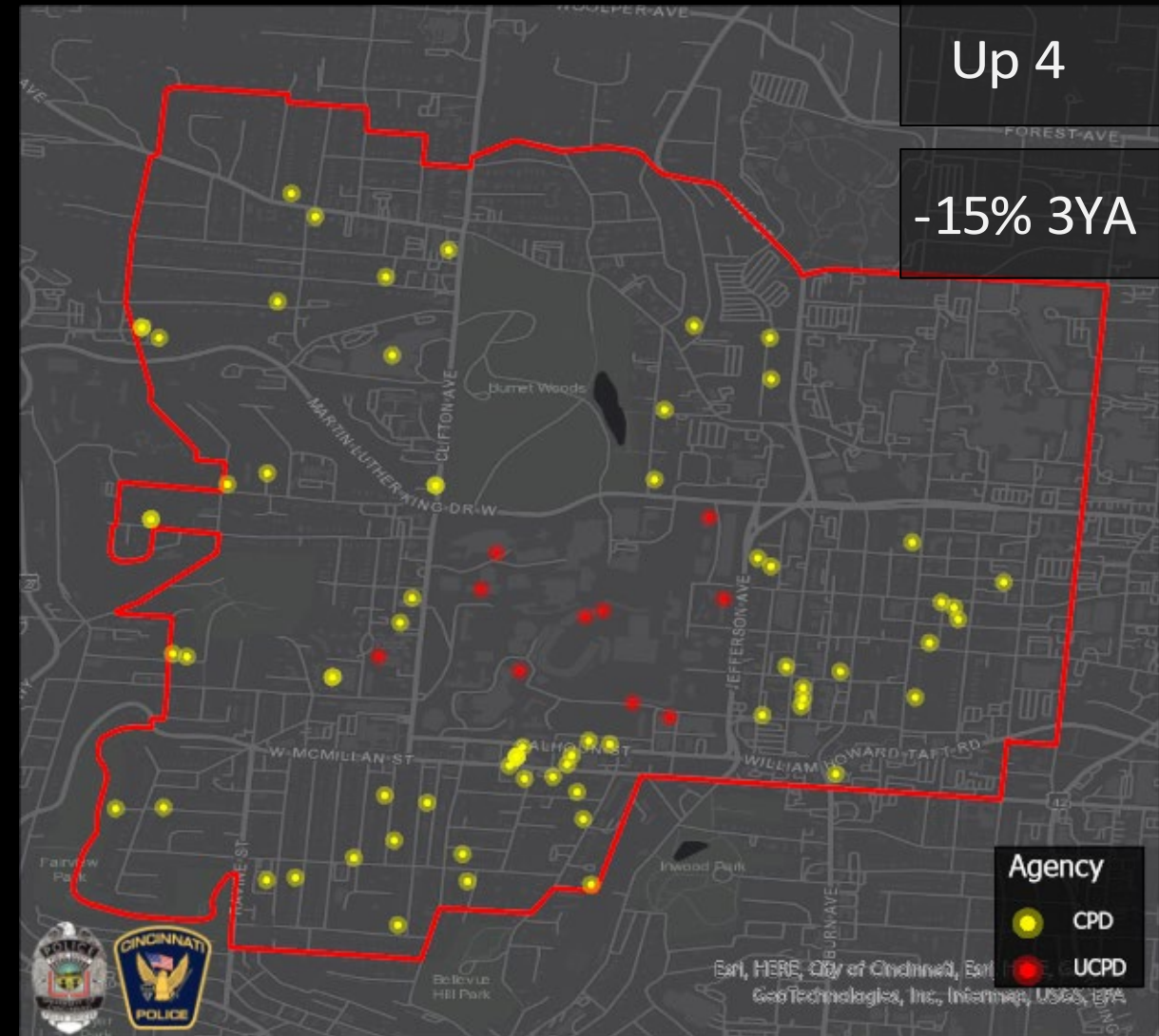


CSR Auto Theft Reports: Year-to-Date

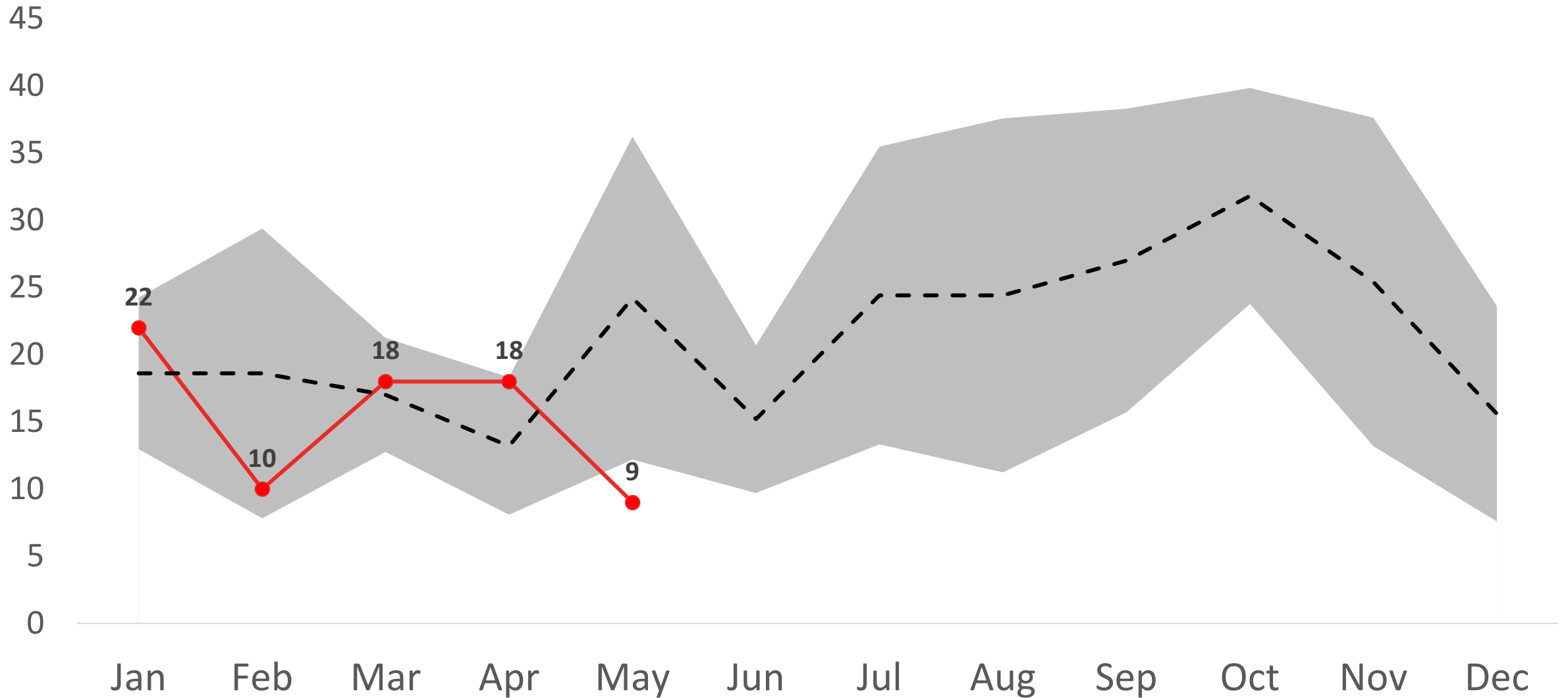

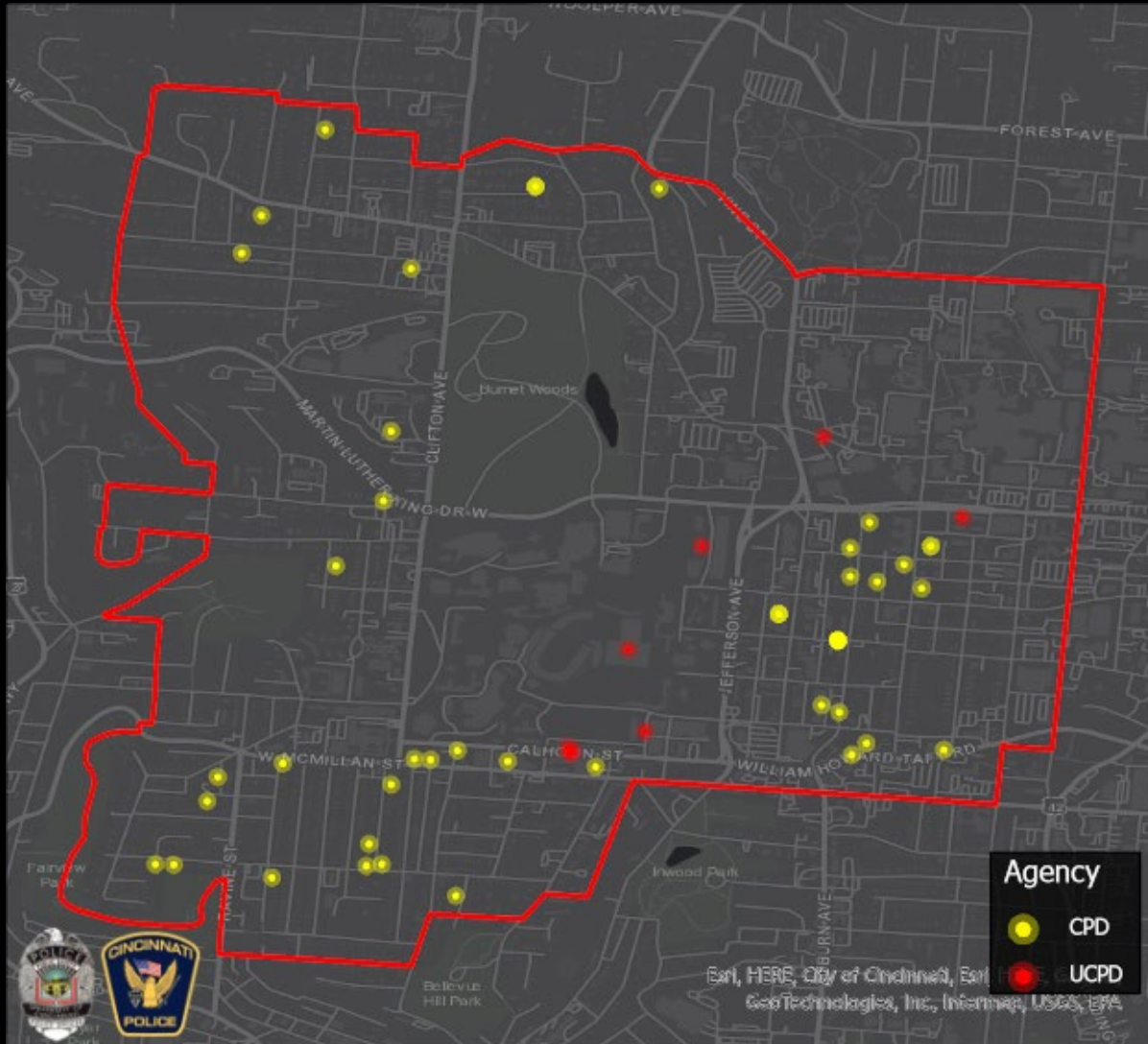
CSR Auto Theft Offenses

● 2026 - - 5 Year Avg

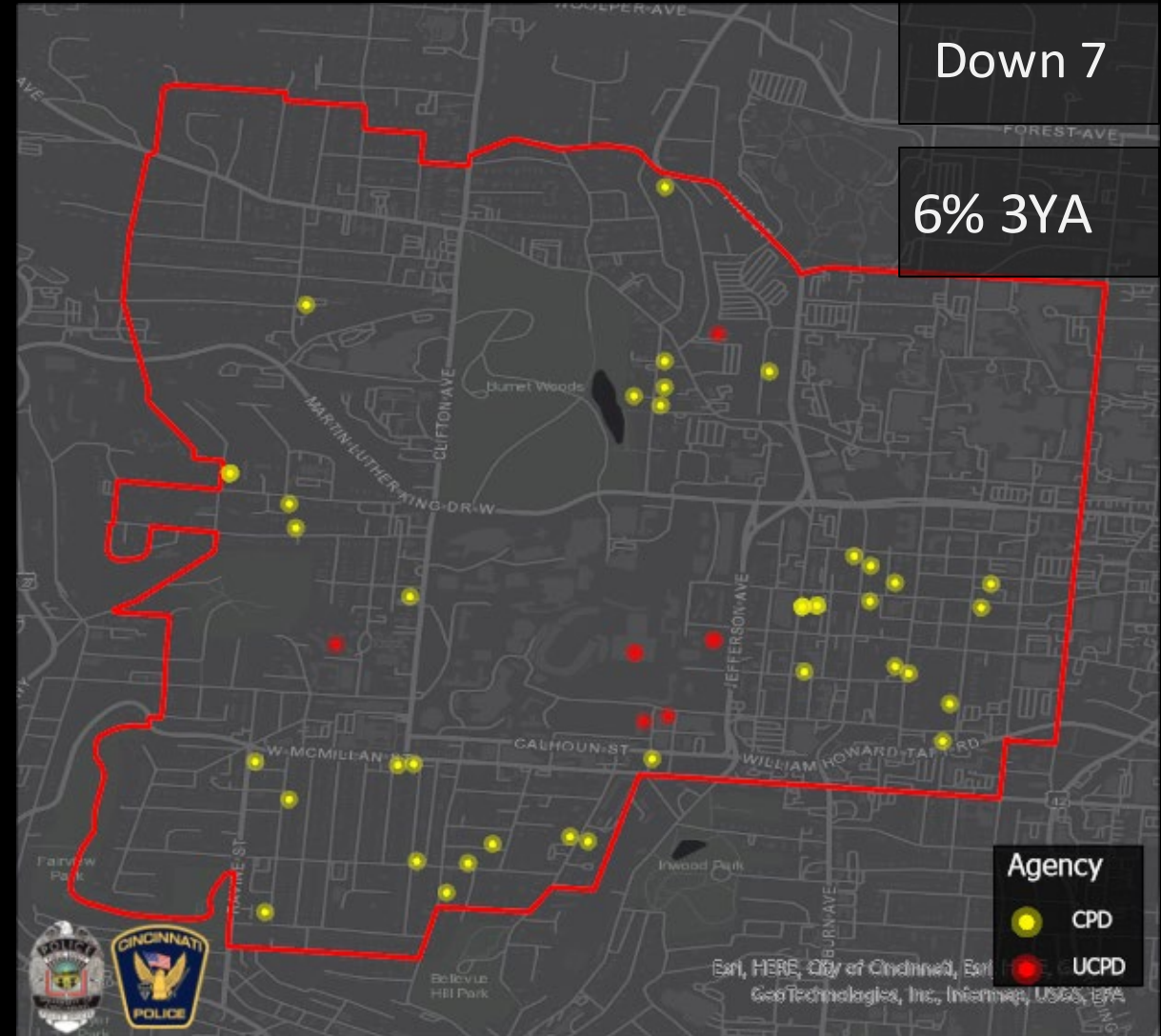


CSR Burglary Reports: Year-to-Date

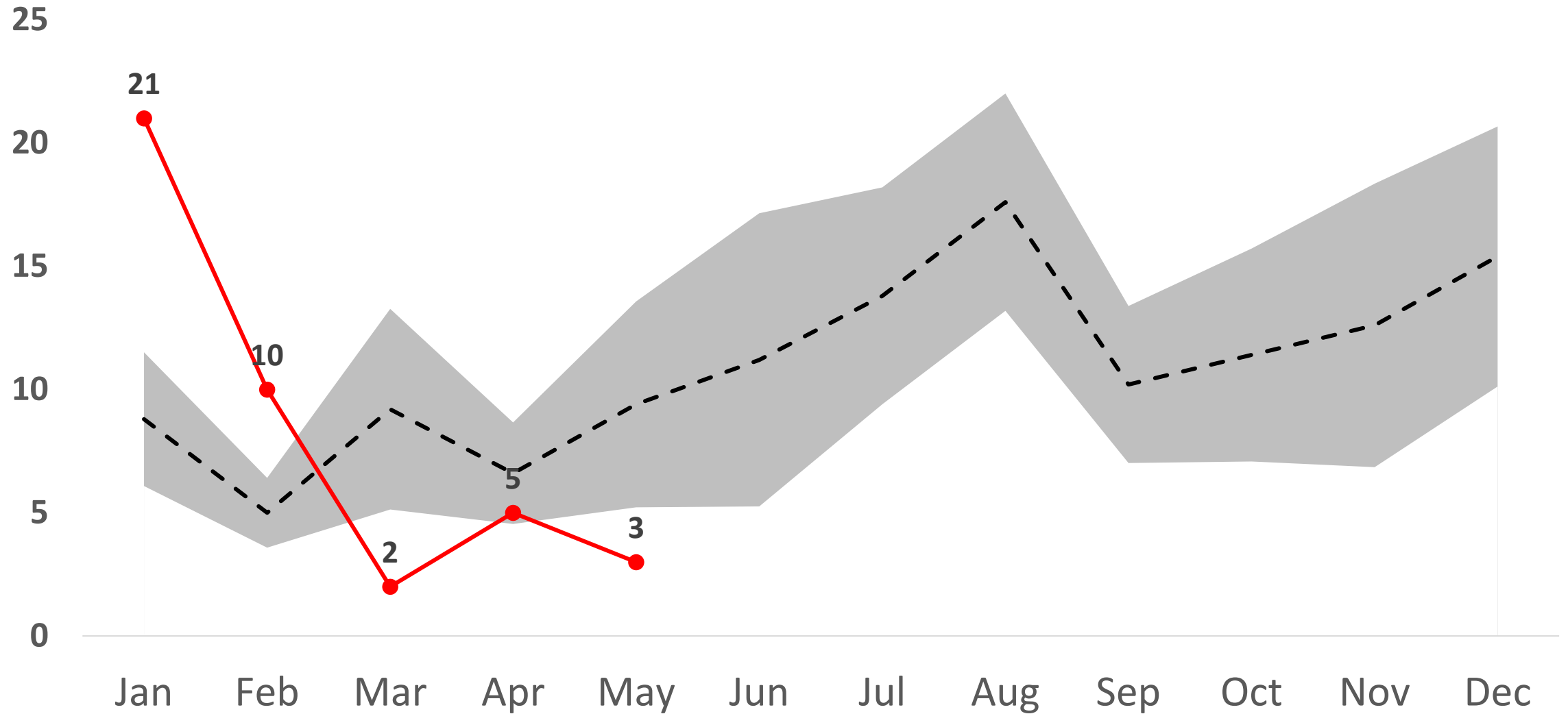

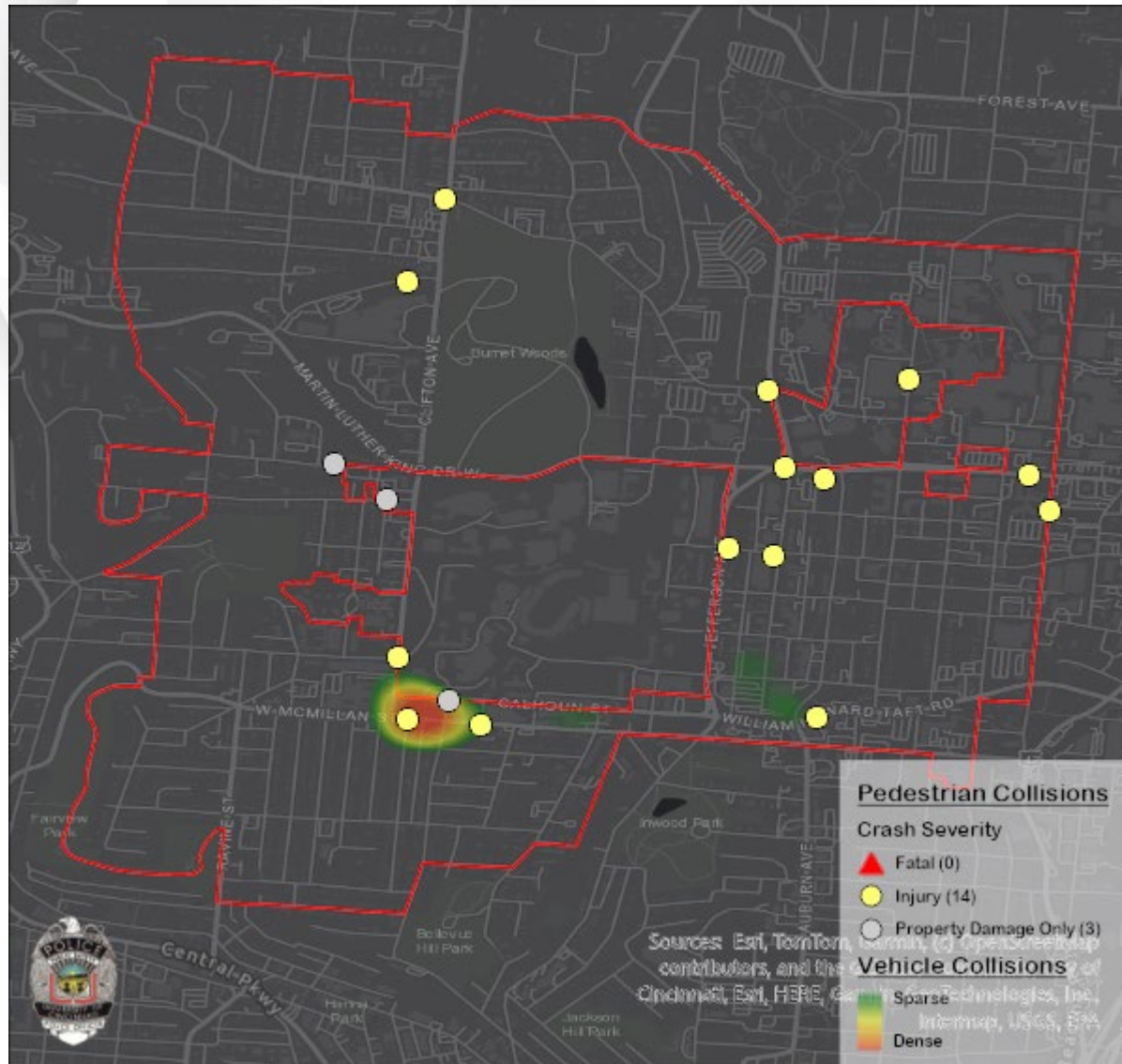
CSR Burglary/Breaking & Entering Offenses

Pedestrian Collisions

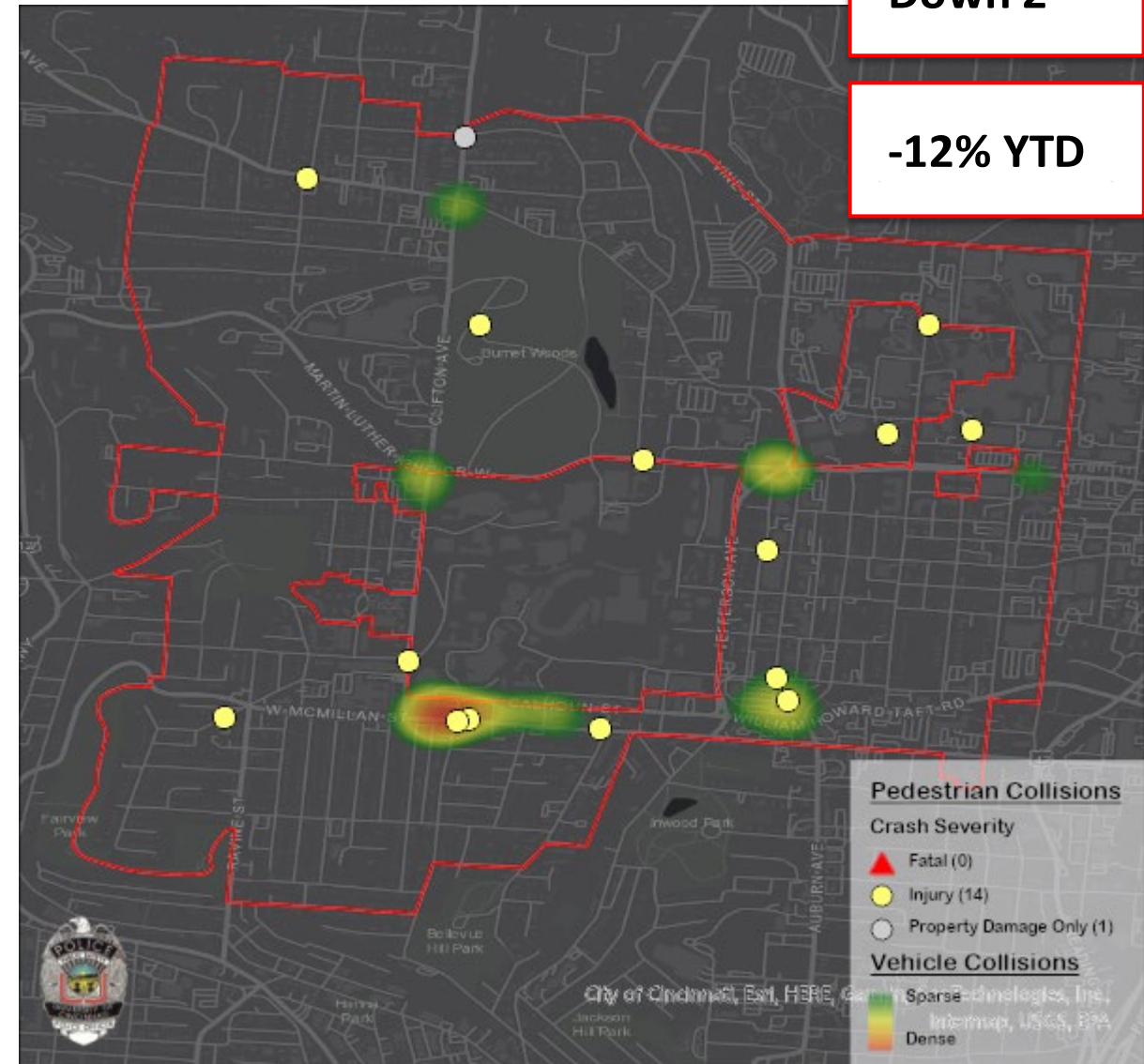

Use of Force

- March 1, 2026: Two police officers used bodily force to arrest a subject who was actively resisting during a disorderly conduct incident.
 - Consistent with training and Use of Force Policy

Display of Force

- March 11, 2026: A Police Officer displayed his firearm at a wanted subject that was ignoring the officer's commands who was known to possibly be armed with a firearm from previous criminal history.
 - Consistent with training and Use of Force Policy
- April 1, 2026: A Police Officer displayed his Taser at a subject while attempting to flee scene from a Shot Spotter alert
 - Consistent with training and Use of Force Policy

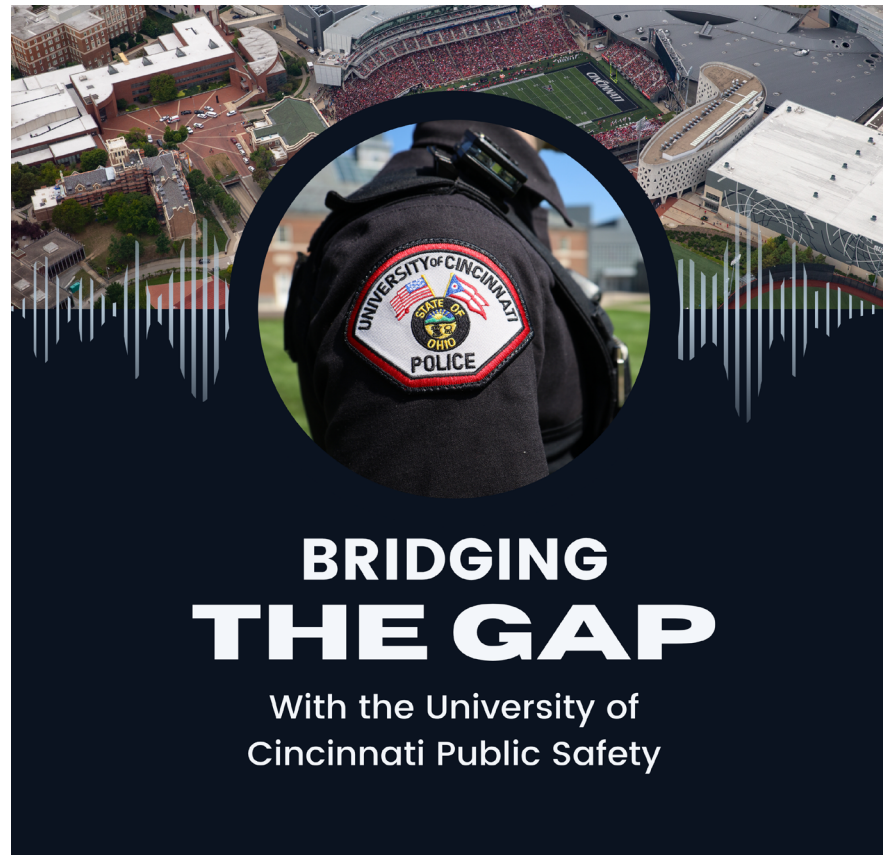
Display of Force

- April 5, 2026: A Police Officer displayed her Taser at a subject that was wanted for discharging a fire extinguisher and fleeing the scene while ignoring the officer's commands
 - Consistent with training and Use of Force Policy
