## TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT ("TAA")

Originating Institution: Central Ohio Technical College ("COTC")

Degree/Program: Associate of Applied Science ("AAS") / Nursing Technology

University of Cincinnati: College of Nursing

Degree/Program: Bachelor of Science / Nursing - RN to BSN (Online) ("RN to BSN (Online)")

**Introduction:** This TAA details the <u>applicability</u> of courses from the COTC AAS Nursing Technology to the University of Cincinnati ("UC") RN to BSN (Online) in the UC College of Nursing. Students who complete the AAS Nursing Technology at COTC have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

**Articulation Overview:** Graduates from COTC AAS Nursing Technology who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Nursing will receive applicable transfer credit toward the RN to BSN (Online) program as outlined below.

**Prerequisite Requirements:** Most students will have completed the majority of the prerequisite requirements in their associate degree program. If not, all prerequisites are complete, a student may be admitted to begin the RN to BSN (Online) program immediately; however, successful completion of all prerequisite courses is required to obtain the BSN degree. Completion of prerequisites while enrolled in the RN to BSN (Online) program may prolong time to degree. Not all prerequisites are offered at UC at all times in an online format. The prerequisite courses can be completed at any <u>regionally accredited</u> institution and transferred to the University of Cincinnati to fulfill the requirement. Prerequisite charts for this partnership can be found in Transfer Degree Map of this document.

Admission Criteria: Completing the courses on the appendices below does not guarantee admission to UC RN to BSN (Online). The RN to BSN (Online) program is designed for individuals who have previously completed an associate degree or diploma in nursing. Complete admission requirements include:

- A completed University of Cincinnati application for undergraduate admission
- All official transcripts from previous colleges attended with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Documented completion of an associate degree in nursing or diploma leading to an RN license
- Application fee
- Confirmation fee (once accepted)

#### Minimum GPA: 2.5 recommended

Official transcripts of previous college coursework with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 recommended. Competitive applications with a GPA below 2.5 will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

**Admission Period**: COTC students must be admitted to the UC College of Nursing during the duration of this TAA (i.e. between August 1, 2025 and July 31, 2027).

**TAA Effective Date**: August 1, 2025 **TAA Expiration Date**: July 31, 2027

## **EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:**

This TAA becomes effective upon its signing and will remain effective through the expiration date noted above. At the end of this time, the TAA will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. COTC and the UC College of Nursing agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting this TAA occur. Additions and/or amendments to this TAA must be in writing and signed by the Parties.

As strong partners, COTC AAS Nursing Technology Program agrees to provide direct access to AAS Nursing Technology students in the last semester of their degree program to a University of Cincinnati representative. This could be in the form of a classroom visit or other opportunities to directly interact and educate students about the RN to BSN (ONLINE) program at the University of Cincinnati. COTC AAS Nursing Technology Program also agrees to provide a graduation list with emails. The UC College of Nursing will provide success rates of incoming cohorts of COTC AAS Nursing Technology Program students upon request.

This TAA will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to changes in program curriculum.

COTC students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.

If all prerequisites are not complete, a student may be admitted to begin the RN to BSN (Online) program immediately; however, successful completion of all prerequisite courses is required to obtain the BSN degree. Completion of prerequisites while enrolled in the RN to BSN (Online) program may prolong time to degree. Not all prerequisites are offered at UC at all times in an online format. The prerequisite courses can be completed at any regionally accredited institution and transferred to UC to fulfill the requirement.
