**Originating Institution:** Lorain County Community College

**Degree/Program:** Associate of Arts (AA), Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathway (OGTP) / Communication

**Target Institution:** University of Cincinnati / College of Arts & Sciences

**Degree/Program:** Bachelor of Arts (BA) / Communication

**Introduction:** This agreement details the applicability of courses from the Lorain County Community College AA OGTP Communication to the BA Communication in the UC College of Arts & Sciences. Students who complete the AA OGTP Communication at Lorain County Community College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

**Articulation Overview:** Graduates from Lorain County Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the College of Arts & Sciences will enter with 61 hours of transfer credit applicable toward the BA Communication degree.

**Admission Criteria:** \*Note: completing the courses on the appendices below does not guarantee admission to the UC BA Communication program.

**Minimum GPA:** 2.0

**BA Completion:** Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.

**Admission Period:** Lorain County Community College students must be admitted to the UC College of Arts & Sciences during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between June 2023 and July 2026).

**Agreement Execution Date:** June 2023

**Agreement End Date:** July 2026

## EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Lorain County Community College and the UC College of Arts & Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

**Lorain County Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.**
