- Science GPA: 3.00 in all science courses
- Science Requirement: 1 course of Natural Science (any combination of Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics, or Environmental Studies) completed at Thomas More University. If transferring outside of this pathway, 2 courses of Natural Science are required as a part of standard transfer admission for this major.
