Introduction: This agreement details the <u>applicability</u> of courses from the Washington State College of Ohio AA Social Services
Transfer to the BS Substance Abuse Counseling (Online) in the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, & Human Services.
Students who complete the AA Social Services Transfer at Washington State College of Ohio have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement for the major.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from Washington State College of Ohio who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, & Human Services will enter with 45 hours of transfer credit applicable toward the BS Substance Abuse Counseling (Online) degree.

Admission Criteria: *Note: completing the courses on the appendices below does not guarantee admission to the UC BS Substance Abuse Counseling (Online) program.

Minimum GPA: 2.0

BS Completion: Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.

Admission Period: Washington State College of Ohio students must be admitted to the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, & Human Services during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between June 1, 2024 and July 31, 2027).

Agreement Execution Date: June 1, 2024 Agreement End Date: July 31, 2027

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for the duration outlined above. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Washington State College of Ohio and the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, & Human Services agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

Washington State College of Ohio students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
